



Blossom finger painting

This spring craft is brilliant for babies and toddlers.



Make a blossom picture at home with this easy finger painting activity.

1. Stick a **twig** to some **card**. Let it dry.
2. Pour some **white and pink paint** onto a **paper plate**.
3. Dip your little one's fingers into the paint and help them dab it alongside the twig to create blossom. Easy peasy!

Grown-ups: Babies and toddlers are physical learners. They learn a lot about the world through their senses. Finger painting is a tactile way for them to explore colour, shape and texture. Plus it's great messy fun!

Look out for blossom growing on trees and hedges in spring.
