Footie's Fun Day has been created in absence of sports day. We would love to see as many school children as possible take part as keeping children active at this time is very important. Event instructions and demonstration videos are on our website and include options for Years 1-4 and Years 5-7.

Schools that take part will be entered into a draw for a chance of winning:

- an equipment pack
- a fun PE day with your local Let Them Play Officer (when schools re-open)
- a special mention on our online channels

Children that take part will be entered into a draw for a chance of winning:

- a football
- a t-shirt
- an at-home training pack
- a special mention on our online channels

The process:

- Teachers share information of Footie's Fun Day with their class and encourage them to take part.
- Inform children that they can take part in as many events as they wish.
- Ask parents/guardians to share a photo or video on Twitter tagging your school and the Irish FA Foundation: **@IFAFootballDev**, using the hashtag **#FootiesFunDay**.
- Encourage children to wear their school colours, or a Northern Ireland shirt. (Optional)
- Recording of results by the school is not necessary.
- Send children who take part the attached electronic certificate. (Optional)

To enter your school into the draw, please share with the Let Them Play Officer for your area some evidence of your school taking part, a few pictures, or a link to a write-up on your school website, for example. To enter children into the draw, please provide the Let Them Play Officer for your area with a list of children's names. Please share Year Group, Teacher's name, and child's first name only. If there are 2 or more children of the same name, please include first initial of last name. A spreadsheet is attached.

Footie's Fun Day will run from June 1st-June 5th so pick a day that suits your school or use the full week to take part. Please inform your local Let Them Pay Officer if you intend to take part or have any questions. We ask that names that are to be entered into the draw are submitted by Monday, 8th June. The draw will take place later that week.
